She specializes in German-Jewish culture, Holocaust Studies, gender and film. She is co-editor of the Oxford journal *Leo Baeck Institute Year Book* (with Raphael Gross) and serves, among other public functions, on the Board of Directors and Trustees of the Leo Baeck Institute London and on the selection committee of Studienstiftung's international Leo Baeck Fellowship Programme in German-Jewish Studies. Major publications include *The Golem Returns: From German Romantic Literature to Global Jewish Culture* (2011), and *Jewish Culture in the Age of Globalization* (2011, co-ed. with Sander Gilman). She is currently on research leave to complete her AHRC-funded monograph (co-authored with Sander Gilman) on *Cosmopolitanism and the Jews*
